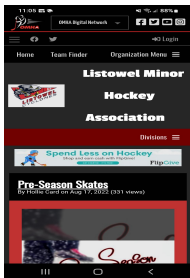




Welcome to Listowel Minor Hockey for the 2022-23 Season from the Board of Directors!

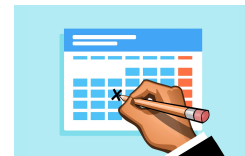
